

SUPERTRAIN 2025 – Floor Plan Review – Version 29 Jan 2025

To find your exhibit in the .pdf diagram (works in Windows with Acrobat; may not work in mail preview)

- With cursor in diagram, press Ctrl F.
- In Find box type in the tag from the Exhibit to Tag table below.
- Hit 'Enter'.
- Exhibit will be in the box shown on the drawing. There will be other exhibits in the box as well. Holding Ctrl and rolling the mouse wheel will blow up the drawing.
- If this does not find your exhibit, contact me at Registrar@supertrain.ca.

Drawing Interpretation

- Heavy green lines are the boundaries of the paid show floor area; the admissions area is at the top of the drawing for, vehicle access reserve during load-in and load-out is at the bottom. The loading ramp is at the middle bottom.
- Blue boxes are booths for Commercial and Display exhibits. Most have red squiggly lines on three sides, red is 8' back drapes, black is 3' side drapes.
- Booth dimension is the front public side; all booths are 10' deep.
- Black boxes are Hobby exhibits. If barriers were requested, an interior green line/ box is the requested space.
- Dimensions shown are of the black box including any requested barrier, usually 1 ½ ft.
- Some preliminary chairs are shown in rest areas. Exhibit-requested tables and chairs are not included in the drawing but will be distributed by our contractor at the show.

Check that

- Your exhibit is present. If not, contact me as above.
- If barrier space was requested, check that there is a green line or lines in your space. You must bring your own barriers.
- Check that the dimensions (over barriers if requested) are correct.
- If you requested two sides to the public (public side is the first dimension in the application) confirm that second side is on the correct (right or left) side of the public side.
- Where booths with less than all sides to the public are back-to-back, there will usually be a (low or high) drape between them.
- If requested in your application, check that proximity to other exhibits is present.

Action:

- If everything is correct, no response is required. Nil response will be interpreted as 'Everything is OK'.
- If there are discrepancies between your application and what is on the drawing, let me know.
- If you have any other comments or concerns, let me know.

Next (hopefully final) floor plan iteration will be issued at the end of February. Comments by mid-February would be appreciated.
